

Worship Team Job Descriptions

Leader / Director

1. pick out setlist, text group no later than Monday (preferred the week before)
 2. manage, delegate, and keep others accountable for tasks
 3. fill in occasionally as “front man” to lead congregation
 4. oversee media team, train sound guys, schedule volunteers.
 5. build relationships with team away from church property
 6. make chord charts for new songs, upload to website
 7. make “executive” decisions on rare occasions that may be an exception from regular policy or routine. Take the heat and lead through it.
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Lead singer / “front man”

1. engage congregation to bring continuity for songs and overall worship experience
 2. engage band in practice, include each member and give direction
 3. know songs better than anyone, orchestrate mechanics such as tempo, arrangement,
 4. start and stop songs
 5. provide spiritual leadership publicly with transitions and scripture.
 6. work directly under the leader / director and submit to that leadership if there is a “creative difference”
 7. run ipad (onsong) / lyrics from stage
